**IOWA**

**Funding**

- \$50,000 State and federal funding allocated under WIA Title I
- 25% of funding from federal resources
- Employers provide in-kind contributions

**Current Initiative/s**

- Iowa has a current initiative in conjunction with business, industry and national skills councils.

**Barriers to Workplace Education**

- There are no barriers confronting workplace education in Iowa.

**Location of programs**

- 90% of programs are offered in the workplace.

**Responsibility for implementation at the local level**

- Community colleges
- Employers

**Support Services**

- Training
- Curriculum development
- Policies and support for one-stops

**One-Stop Connections**

- Workplace education programs are connected to the one-stops. The Adult Basic Education coordinator is responsible for these programs.
