

# THE STATE OF WORKPLACE EDUCATION IN THE STATES

## KANSAS

### Funding

- 60% of workplace education in Kansas was funded with Federal money, 30% state, and 10% local.
- Additionally, employers have made in-kind contributions, in the form of space and early release time.

### Current Initiatives

There is no current initiative in Kansas to promote workplace education. They are continuing to focus on work-based basic skills such as English as a Second Language.

### Barriers to Workplace Education

- There is a perception in Kansas that there is not a great need for workplace education programs.

### Location of programs

- 90% of work-based basic skills programs are offered on-site.

### Responsibility for implementation at the local level

- Community colleges

### Support Services

- Training

### One-Stop Connections

- Adult workplace education in Kansas is not tied to One-Stops.
