**Funding**

- 75% of funding from federal resources
- Employers provide in-kind contributions

**Current Initiative/s**

- Missouri is currently developing a workplace readiness certificate based on a list of characteristics.
- The workplace readiness certificate is being promoted by the Missouri Chamber of Commerce.
- This initiative is coordinated at the state level and locally driven.

**Barriers to Workplace Education**

- Short-term focus

**Location of programs**

- 30-50% of programs are offered in the workplace.
- Adult Education Learning Centers (AEL) sites
- One-Stops

**Responsibility for implementation at the local level**

- Learning Centers (AELs)

**Support Services**

- Training
- Curriculum development
- Policies and support for One-Stops

**One-Stop Connections**

- Workplace education programs have a connection to the One-Stops but are primarily coordinated through AEL.
