NORTH CAROLINA

Funding

- 25% of the funding from federal resources
- Employers occasionally contribute up to 50% of instructional costs.

Current Initiatives

- There are no current initiatives in the state promoting workplace education.

Barriers to Workplace Education

- State funding is not substantial enough to meet the needs of employers.

Location of programs

- 95% of the programs are offered at the worksite.
- Some programs are offered in the classroom.

Responsibility for implementation at the local level

- Community Colleges
- Employers

Support Services

- Training
- Marketing
- Partnership building (i.e. brokering with state associations)

The workplace education programs in North Carolina have a limited connection to One-Stops.
