

# THE STATE OF WORKPLACE EDUCATION IN THE STATES

## *SOUTH CAROLINA*

### **Funding**

- South Carolina supports its workplace education programs with 50% Federal funds and 50% state and other funds.
- Additionally, employers contribute through in-kind donations.

### **Current Initiatives**

South Carolina maintains a Workplace Resource Center that provides contextual curriculums and teacher training in support of workplace education programs.

### **Barriers to Workplace Education**

- Many local programs are offering classes that focus on soft skills and, therefore, cannot be reimbursed.

### **Location of programs**

- 80% of workplace education programs are offered on-site, with the remainder located in school districts.

### **Responsibility for implementation**

- LEA's

### **Support Services**

- Training
- Curriculum Development

### **One-Stop Connections**

- Adult workplace education initiatives in South Carolina are not connected to One-Stop services.
