

# THE STATE OF WORKPLACE EDUCATION IN THE STATES

## WYOMING

### Funding

- While Wyoming has no funds specifically dedicated to workplace education, the money spent to that end was 75% Federal versus 25% state and other.
- Employers provided no additional contributions.

### Current Initiatives

Thus far, Wyoming has held only a small number of classes in the workplace; however, Wyoming is currently undertaking a new initiative setting up a system for work-based EL/Civics instruction.

### Barriers to Workplace Education

- In order to make more progress with workplace education, Wyoming must combat traditional ways of thinking.

### Location of programs

- The English Language/Civics initiative is not yet completely in place.

### One-Stop Connections

- Adult workplace education initiatives will be connected to One-Stop services in collaboration with local businesses, to which the local Adult Basic Education directors will be directly responsible.
